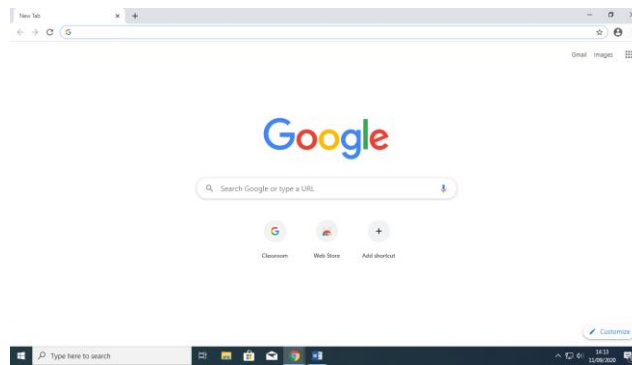
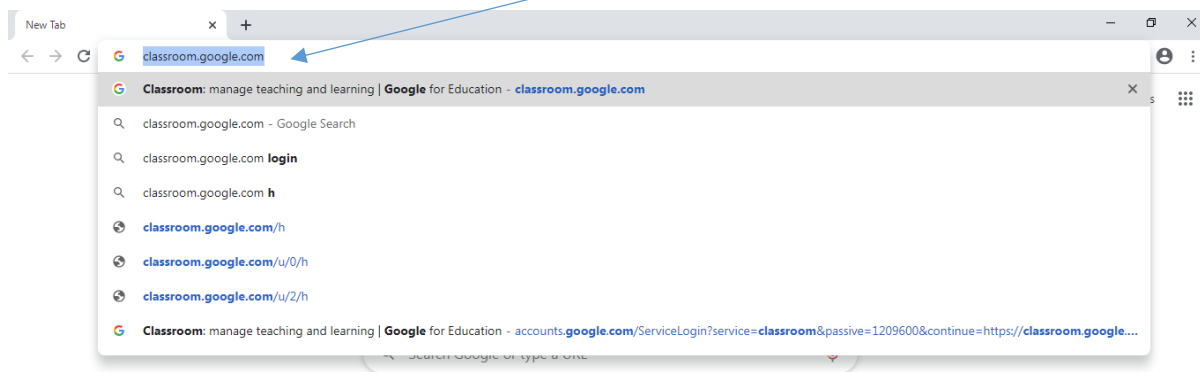


# Google Classroom 2020-2021

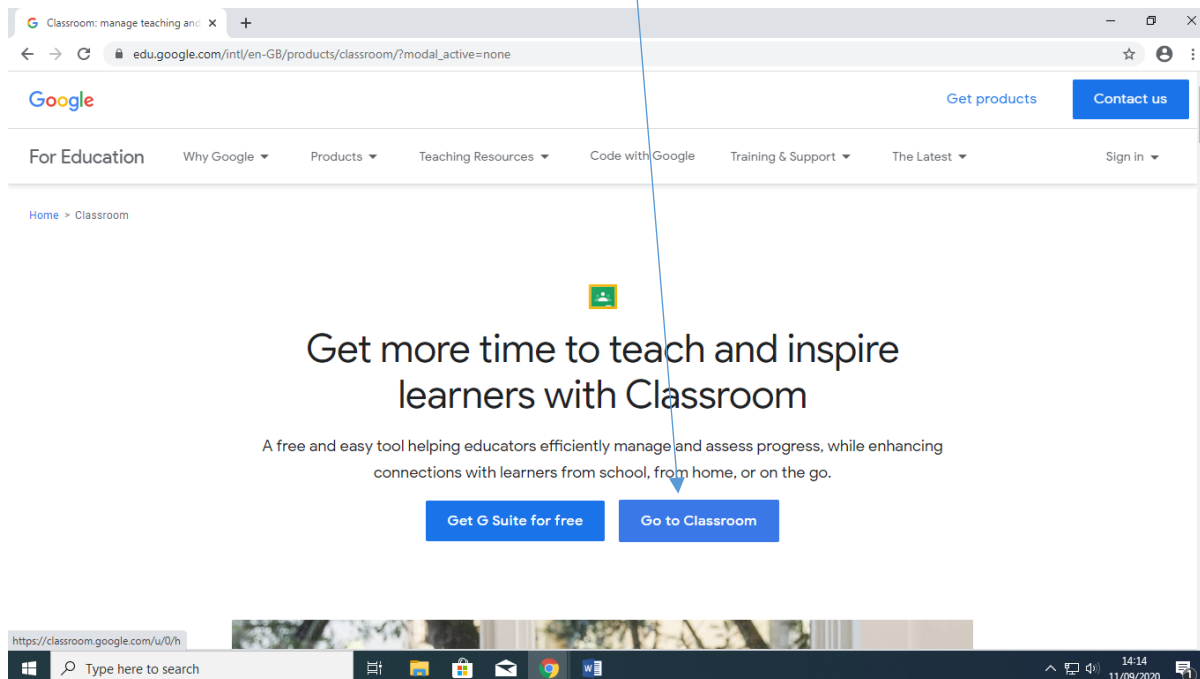
Open Internet Explorer/Chrome/Safari

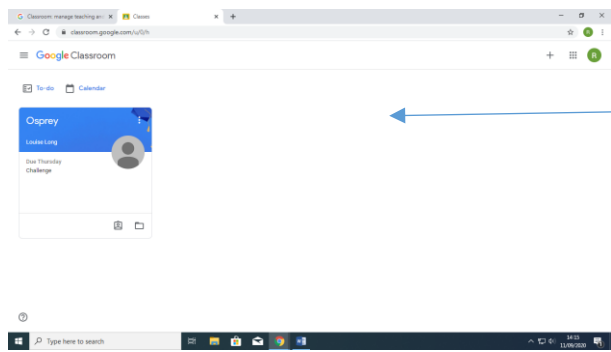

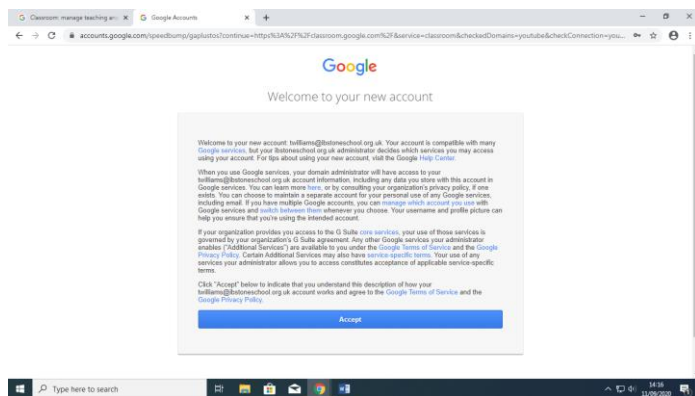

If it is your first visit to the Google Classroom, you will need to follow the next steps, if not, you should see your classes and be able to select a class to see what work is waiting for you.

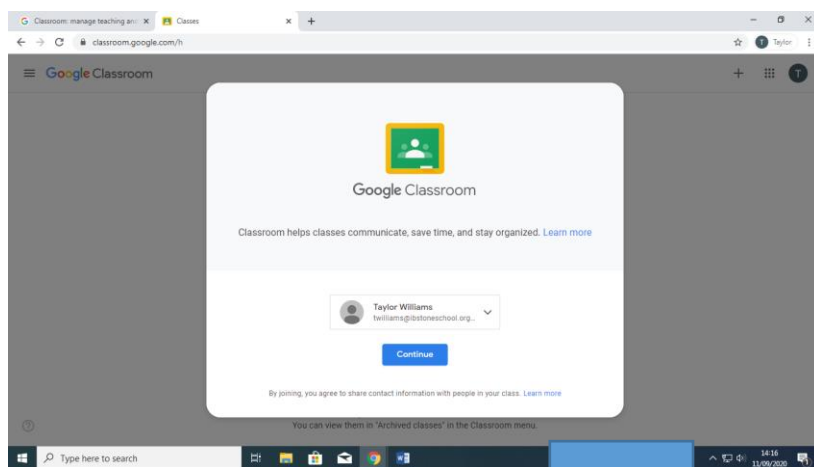

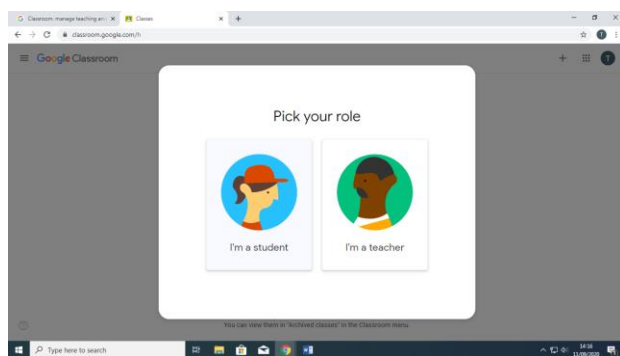
If it is your first visit, please follow these steps. **Click Accept.**



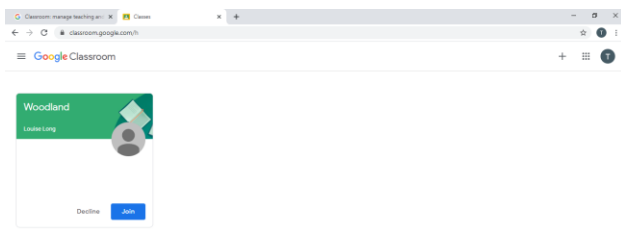

You will then be asked to pick your role. **I'm a student 😊**

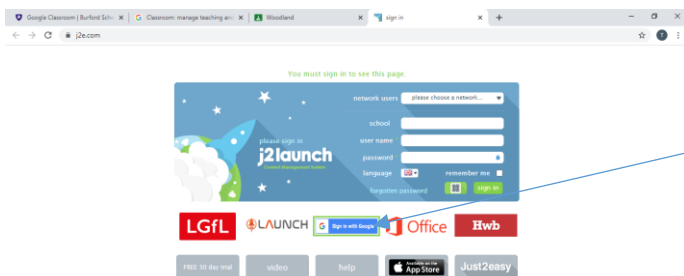
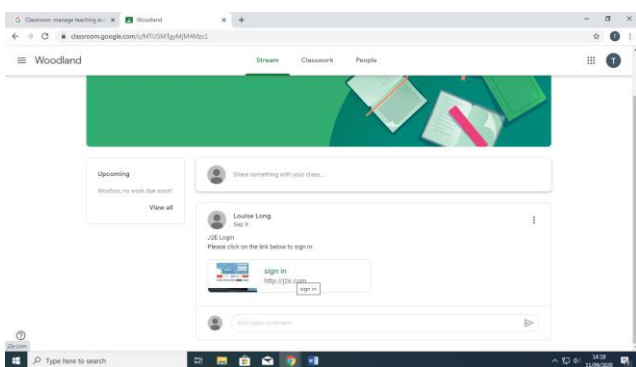


Then you will need to click **Join** to see your classes.



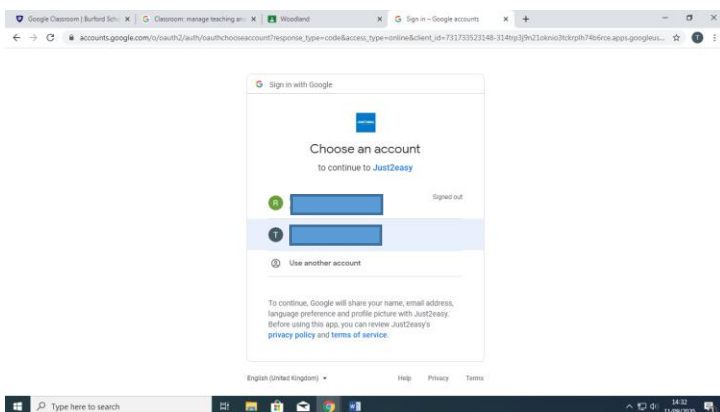
Then you will be able to see your work and messages.

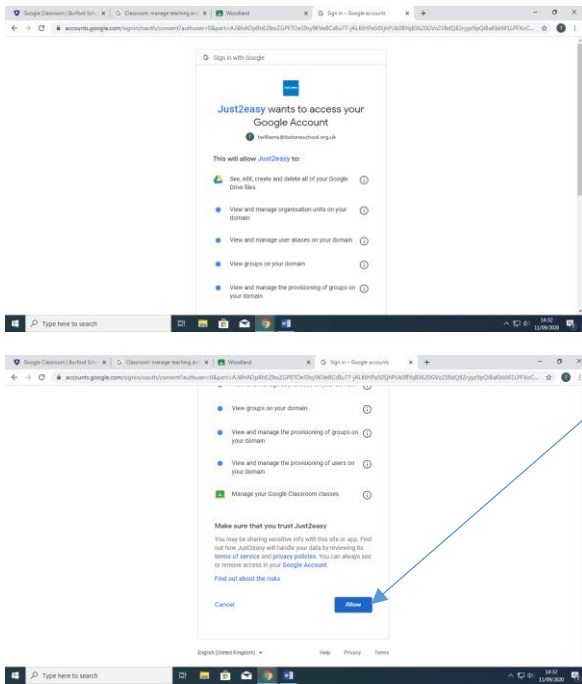


This screen will appear, you will need to click on the button that says: **Sign in with Google**
