Dear Families,

The whole school enjoyed being back together to make the traditional Ibstone School Harvest Loaf this week. It was lovely to hear the older children talking to the younger children about what they had to do and why we make the loaf for the service.









Welcome

A warm Ibstone welcome to Mrs Claire Farrar who has joined the Ibstone Team to work in Osprey Class, I know that the children have been very welcoming this week!

What we have been learning this week...

Ladybirds have been looking at their first Talk 4 Writing story this week, they have enjoying retelling 'Rosie's Walk' using small world toys and acting out the story using masks. They have used actions to tell the story and have followed a story map. Some children have been making their own story maps and retelling the story!





In mathematics, they have been making patterns! They have wowed Mrs Statham with colour patterns, natural material patterns and even musical patterns! They have worked together to paint a story map display of 'Rosie's Walk'





In Woodland Class the children have continued to develop their understanding of the story 'Augustus and his Smile'. This week the children have thought about questions they would like to ask Augustus the tiger and have worked in groups to act out their favourite parts of the story. They have also been learning about adjectives and have used these to describe locations from the story. Year 2 were set an extra challenge to use their adjectives in an expanded noun phrase.

In mathematics, the children have started their work on addition and subtraction. Year 1 have been learning about parts and wholes and have been partitioning numbers up to 10 using a part-whole model. Year 2 have been learning about fact families and have been writing addition and subtraction number sentences for numbers up to 20. They have also been learning how to check calculations by using pictures and reverse operations.

In science, the children have continued to explore the senses. This week, the children were asked to use their senses to write a sensory poem about Autumn.

Kestrel Class have continued editing and writing their innovations of The Canal, they have also been learning about adding -s to the ends of words for both plural and possession. The children wrote some creative sentences about an autumn scene using both plural and possessive.

They have continued reading The Iron Man and started the week by drawing some pictures to help summarise chapter 2. The children then compared chapter 2 and 3 by thinking about how the farmers and Hogarth treated the Iron Man extremely differently. They created a list of open questions to ask the Iron Man to find out how he felt.

In mathematics, Year 3 have moved onto a unit of work on addition and subtraction. They have looked at adding and subtracting multiples of 100 and then adding 2 digit numbers and 1 digit numbers where the answer is crossing into the next ten. Year 4 started off by looking at rounding 4-digit numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000. They then looked at counting in 25s and finished the week by looking at negative numbers.

In history, they have looked at Roman shields and discussed the colours and symbols and their meaning. They also talked about creating symmetrical patterns. The children then designed their our own Roman shields!



Osprey Class have been working on alliteration and enjoyed playing the alliterative animal alphabet. Following on from this and to mark National Poetry Day (Thursday 7th), the children have been set the challenge to write the Ibstone CE Primary School Alliterative A-Z. I look forward to sharing this with you before the end of term.

The whole of Key Stage 2 enjoyed Worship on a Walk this morning and we were all incredibly proud of Zog who was very well behaved during his first Ibstone School walk!



Whilst we were walking, Osprey Class had the opportunity to look at the way in which the recent rain water had made its own path through the woods and spotted the potential for an oxbow lake where water had changed its course, they also spotted a delta, where the sediment had been deposited.
