Scarlet Fever

You will have heard lots about Scarlet Fever in the news recently, we do not currently have any cases in school, however, we will inform you if we do. We have already upped the hand washing and will continue to encourage children to use tissues for sneezes!

Strep A/ Scarlet Fever infections can cause a range of symptoms that parents should be aware of, including:

- * Sore throat
- * Headache
- * Fever
- * A fine, pinkish or red body rash with a sandpapery feel
- * On darker skin the rash can be more difficult to detect visually but will have a sandpapery feel

As the weather is due to get much colder next week, please make sure that your child has a hat and gloves in school at all times, all children will also need lots of layers to wear for Forest School.
