Weekly Round Up

Ladybirds

In Ladybirds this week we have been taking part in Drawing Club, we enjoyed the story of The Christmas Pine and have written some fabulous codes to make

exciting things happen. We have also been developing our vocabulary with words such as irridescent, gape, absent and warble, we have actions to help us deepen our knowledge of these words. We have thought about what our Christmas Pine looks like, where this is and how we were able to transport it. We have been enjoying lots of Christmas crafts and making our Christmas cards.

In mathematics we have continued learning about shape with a focus on squares and rectangles; we had fun searching the school for as many shapes as we could find. We have been building and making lots of shape pictures. We have also thought about day and night and the different activities that happen, the children were able to remember a lot of the nocturnal animals that would be active at night.

It has been assessment week in phonics, along with this we have focused on letter formation and looking at capital letters.



Woodland Class

In English, Woodland Class have been busy writing fact files about their newly discovered creatures. There have been lots of new and interesting creatures including Sparkle Foxes, Cramels and three-headed wolves. The children focused on using conjunctions to extend their sentences and have written some amazing fact files.

In mathematics, Year 1 have continued learning about shapes and have enjoyed making pictures using 2D shapes. Year 2 have been using their addition and subtraction knowledge to solve addition and subtraction problems.

The children have also been very busy rehearsing their Nativity and are looking forward to their performance next week.

Kestrel Class

In English this week, the children have been looking at a toolkit for recounts and discussed the different features they can include. As a class, we identified

these within our focus text 'Jungle Log: 18th February 2020' and then the children worked in groups to also identify these features within another recount. They planned and have written their own recount about a trip to the rainforest.

In mathematics, Nemos have finished their first multiplication and division unit by looking at the 4 and 8 times table. Frogs have been using all their skills learnt this term to complete a range of different activities that require them to reason and problem solve.

In science, the children learnt about electrical conductors and insulators. We explored what they are and then discussed the importance of them. The children then selected items from around the classroom to test. They first had to predict whether they thought the item would be an insulator or a conductor and then they added it to a simple series circuit to test their predictions.



Osprey Class

We've had a busy week practising our Nativity this week, we are really looking forward to performing it next week at Garsington.

In English, we started writing up our persuasive brochure for our summer camp. We really like having the opportunity to be creative in with our English work.

In mathematics we have looked at negative numbers. It's really interesting to see when we use negative numbers in the real world.

Barn Owls

In mathematics this week, we have continued to work on our arithmetic skills. We have considered different approaches to adding numbers and revised how to use the column method to add and to subtract.

In English, we have continued our work on instructions. At the beginning of the week, we made some beautiful Christmas cards thinking carefully about each step along the way. Later in the week we wrote instructions to teach other people how to make the cards.
