#### Dear Families,

The Ladybirds have continued to learn about Fairy Tales, they enjoyed making and tasting porridge for Goldilocks and the Three Bears. They have been using positional language to describe where that naughty Goldilocks had left the chairs and bowls. The children used scales to weigh out the indgredients to make their own gingerbread people! The children have all enjoyed acting out the stories and performing them to a variety of audiences! It was great to see some of the Ladybirds' parents at Stay and Play, it is so important for you to be part of your child's learning journey and we hope you enjoyed coming in to be part of their learning.









Woodland Class had a WOW moment on Monday morning as their classroom had been transformed to look like an Indian town! The children all went on a magic carpet ride across India, they saw some amazing sights, such as the Taj Mahal, elephants and beautiful flower markets. On their return, the children had to make a list of all the sights they had seen. They also made a storyboard as a visual aid to support their writing over the next few weeks.









In mathematics, they have continued to make arrays and learning about multiplication. The children had to use their knowledge of the 2,5 & 10 times tables to buy goods at the Indian market. The have had some challenging word problems to solve too!

Kestrel Class have created a huge imaginary world this week. In groups they drew a quarter of the map that was then pieced together to create an imaginary world. I am looking forward to being able to share more about their adventures next week.

In mathematics they have been multiplying, ordering negative numbers, revisiting number bonds and adding 2 and 3 digit numbers! In art, they drew and coloured imaginary planets and then made them into exploding planets!
