What have we been learning this week?

Apart from learning how to run a pancake race, discussing what they would like to do for Lent, discussing their favourite books and singing along to The Greatest Showman, the children have also been busy in their classes.

The Ladybirds have been making stained glass windows in the shape of Elmer. They have been learning about numbers and thinking about number bonds. In literacy, they have been making story maps about an Elmer adventure.

Woodland Class have been finding out about Samuel Pepys and how his diary helped us learn about the Great Fire of London. They have also been thinking about time and have made a weekly diary to show what they do over the course of the week. The children have also linked their learning about fractions and positional language and directions to help them tell the time. Year 1 have been learning how to tell the time to o'clock and half past on an analogue clock and Year 2 have been telling the time using quarter past and quarter to. The children enjoyed using the appartus in PE.
