What have we been learning this week?

Ladybirds have been thinking about hot and cold colours this week. They have made a collage to suit the mood of a hot or cold colour. They have also made a 'Thingamajig' and written some descriptive sentences. In mathematics, they have been estimating time, capacity and groups of objects.

Woodland Class have been writing non chronological reports about the Hindu festival of Holi. They have also been writing
