What have we been learning this week?

Ladybirds have continued to enjoy retelling the story of 'Whatever Next' and have been writing their own version of the story where they zoom off to Mars! The children have all had a go at writing their stories independently and have wowed us with their writing skills! Keep up the good work Ladybirds!

In mathematics, they have been been estimating and measuring how much different objects weigh and comparing them using vocabulary such as heavier, lighter, heaviest and lightest. The children have also enjoyed making a spaceship using reclaimed materials and using the computers to make space pictures.

Woodland Class have continued their Unicorn and Dragon stories and have been using their Talk for Writing skills to rehearse their descriptions and improve their ideas before writing them. In mathematics they have been multiplying and dividing numbers by 2,5 & 10, solving word problems and two step problems. Woodland Class are really enjoying their cricket sessions with the England Cricket Board through their Chance to Shine programme.

Kestrel Class have been writing newspaper reports about an alien visiting Ibstone. In mathematics they have been focussing on subtraction and have been using the trading method to subtract up to 4 digit numbers. They have also been solving word problems. In science, the children have been learning about gravity, air resistance and friction. They have designed a parachute that could slow down the rate of an egg falling to earth so that it will not break, I shall look forward to sharing the photos of the experiment next week.

Staffing News



We look forward to seeing you at the May Fayre in Marlow on Saturday.


