Special Visitors at Kites Holiday Club

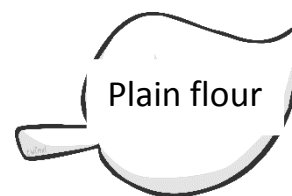
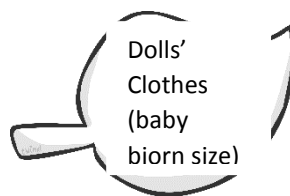
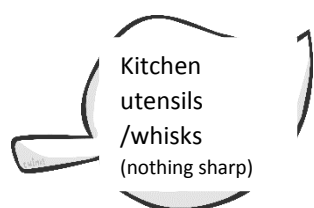
