What have we been learning this week...

Ladybirds have been learning about sunflowers this week. They have been looking at Vincent Van Gogh's Sunflowers and have painted their own version. They all enjoyed writing instructions about how to plant a sunflower and then had a go at following their instructions. Hopefully they will be bringing home their sunflowers in a few weeks time. In mathematics, they have been estimating and measuring length using unifix cubes.
