What have we been learning this week...

The Ladybirds have been drawing story maps in small groups to make up their own version of 'Rosie's Walk'. They have practiced telling the story orally and a few children have had a go at writing their stories. I particularly loved hearing about Rainbow the Flamingo who flew over the elephants!

In mathematics the children have really enjoyed using Bee Bot (a floor robot) to develop their positional language and programming skills. They had to help Bee Bot navigate a maze of bricks!

Woodland Class have had a very exciting week, on Tuesday Mimble the mischief making monster caused havoc in school! He had stolen books and slippers from Osprey and Kestrel Class and he had left clues around the school to help the children find him. The children carefully solved the clues and went on a monster hunt to find him! The found him up a tree in the woods! The children had to write instructions about how they were going to catch Mimble and get him down from the tree! They will be testing our their instructions next week and finding out which method worked best!

In mathematics the children have continued to learn about 3D shapes, they have looked at the nets of 3D shapes and described the shapes of the faces before making the net. The children thoroughly enjoyed making their net monsters.



Kestrel Class have continued using 'The Canal' as their talk for writing focus this week, they have been discussing how the characters feelings change throughout the story and have been comparing characters feelings. The children also had the challenge of writing the story using the class text map. In mathematics they have been using money to add different amounts, they have been investigating how many ways you can make different amounts such as 'How many different ways can you make 36p?' The children have also been converting pence to pounds and vice versa using decimal points.

The children enjoyed acting out the Roman invasion of Britain and enjoyed showing off their marching and tortoise formation to Osprey Class.





Osprey Class have been writing diary entries about Bill's time as an evacuee. They have used the text to help them think about how to express how Bill was feeling during this time. All the children are enjoying reading 'Fireweed' and are excited to find out what will happen now that Bill is back in London during the Blitz.

In mathematics they have been working with statistics and have drawn and interpreted line graphs. They have also been using times tables to answer and solve problems.

Forest School

Our Year 1 and 2 children honoured remembrance day this week by painting poppy tree cookies, they all had a go at using a hand drill to drill a hole through the wood.







Osprey Class decided to work as a team this week to make a 'Mudgloo'. I wonder if any of the garden wildlife will move in now the colder weather has arrived?
