What have we been learning this week...

The Ladybirds have been writing rhyming strings and adding a new line to Hickory Dickory Dock, they have also been making puppets and learning to sew. They also enjoyed putting on a puppet show! In mathematics, they have been

ordering numbers and playing maths games which involved 1 more and 1 less.

Woodland Class have enjoyed learning about Grace Darling this week, they have found out how she became a hero and made stormy sea pictures. They also made their own light houses! On Thursday the children had a special visitor in the classroom. Mrs Hampson brought Stanley the tortoise to school to meet the children. They thoroughly enjoyed writing fact files about Stanley and everyone made a paper plate model of Stanley to take home.



Kestrel Class have finished their Canal stories and have edited them before re drafting them. Miss Firth has been wowed by the amazing vocabulary some of the children have used. In mathematics they have been using money to find change from different amounts.

This week Osprey Class have been writing newspaper articles about the first day of the Blitz. They have acted like reporters finding out what happened, they have listened to eye witness accounts and used them to include quotes in their articles. In mathematics they have been solving problems using factors and common factors. They have used their knowledge of prime and square numbers to solve problems and have investigated and made cubed numbers!

Forest School

It was a little WET in Forest School this week. All of the groups discovered how the school grounds change in the rain and found that mud is a little messy!

Year 1 sheltered from the weather under the fir tree and made tree faces using clay. Year 2 also enjoyed tree painting and playing with the clay. There was plenty of natural mud 'paint'! They also showed some great teamwork making dens, including a natural den with the branches from the bottom of the hill.



Year 5/6 faced possibly the wettest weather of the day but made good use of the small streams that flowed down the hill into basecamp.... they channelled the water, dug out collection pools, rigged up bucket pulley systems and explored how the water flowed downhill.... before enjoying some big splashes!
