Dear Families,

It has been a very busy week here in school, the children have settled into their new classes well and are demonstrating their eagerness to learn! The classrooms are looking incredible with their smart new tables and chairs. A huge thank you to the PTA for funding all of our new tables and chairs over the last 18 months, your fundraising means a lot to us!

What have we been learning this week...

The Ladybirds have started their 'Ourselves' topic and have listen to the Titch stories, been writing their names and using their senses to explore the school grounds. In mathematics they have been counting sets of objects and practising their number formation. They enjoyed painting their self portraits and have made a wonderful display of information about themselves and their paintings.





Woodland Class have been learning about their senses, they have written about each of their 5 senses. In mathematics they have been learning about place value, they have been looking at what each digit in a two digit number represents, some of the Year 2 children have been investigating place value in numbers to 100. They have enjoyed finding about 'People Who Help Us' and can name the three emergency services and know to dial 999 for the emergency services.

It is Roald Dahl Day today and the Woodland Class enjoyed listening to a few chapters of The Giraffe, The Pelly & Me this morning before they had to step inside the Pelicans beak! They had to use their senses to think about what they might feel, hear, smell, see and taste as they stepped in!

There was a lot of squelchy slime, stringy goo and frothy foam to see and feel. They could hear the brittle fish bones crunching and there was a nasty smell of rotten eggs! Sounds pleasant!

Kestrel Class have been describing characters and settings. In mathematics they have been learning about place value counting in 100's to 100 and beyond. They have been using dienes to represent numbers and have been writing numbers in numerals and in words. Kestrel Class have also started to find out about the Romans and are looking forward to learning more next week. In science they have been asked to become personal trainers to help a hockey team develop their team by working on fitness and nutrition. The children will be making group Powerpoint presentations to share their vision as personal trainers.

Osprey Class have been reading The Highwayman and looking at the structure of the poem, analysing and annotating it verse by verse. They have chosen a character to be from the poem and are writing a narrative from their point of view. In mathematics they have also been learning about place value and have been exploring numbers into and over tens of thousands. In science they have been investigating the properties of materials and have been looking at whether they are magnetic, permeable and whether they conduct electricity.
