Dear Families,

Thank you to everyone who met with me on Zoom this week, it was lovely to see you all and touch base!

What have we been learning this week...

Ladybirds have been on a dinosaur adventure this week. They have found out about many different types of dinosaurs, they have chosen their favourite and have been finding out facts about them, such as, what they eat (the children have enjoyed learning new vocabulaty such as herbivore and carnivore), how their teeth differed depending on whether they were plant or meat eaters and where they lived. The children enjoyed making a dinosaur habitat and were very creative with their designs.



In mathematics they have been finding out about sharing and halving and have had to teach their dinosaurs to share fairly between 2, 3 and 4 dinosaurs! The children were very excited to discover a toad hiding in the water tray!



In Woodland Class, The Lions Group have been drawing story maps and planning their own version of Handa's Surprise. They have been writing about where they would like to visit in Africa and had to explain why they had chosen South Africa, Mauritius, Eygpt or Kenya.

In mathematics that have been looking at lines of symmetry in 2D shapes and have made some lovely symmetrical butterflies and patterns. They have been challenged to make Arfican rain sticks this week and they also been working hard to make their African Sunsets.



Safari Group have moved on from their Kenyan Safari and have made their way to the Kalahari Desert, they have met a special meerkat called Sunny and have enjoyed learning the story Meerkat Mail. They have also been making their African Sunsets!


In mathematics, they have been working out fractions of amounts and have had some tricky fraction word problems to solve!

They have also started their investigation in to 'Why meerkats can't live at the North Pole'!

Kestrel Class have been learning how apostrophes can be used for omission in contractions. They have also looked at the 4 different types of sentences (commands, questions, statements and exclamations), they have been challenged to identify and write examples of each sentence type.

In mathematics they have been identifying right angles, acute angles and obtuse angles in shapes, they have also been finding out about the properties of the different types of angles.

In their Troll Island project, a new animal has been discovered and the children have had to write a fact file about the new creature!



The whole of KS2 have been comparing places of worship. They have also been looking at Andy Warhol's pop art and have created their own sunglasses in the style of Andy Warhol!





Osprey Class have finshed their class text 'When the Whales Came', everyone really enjoyed it and for some it has been named as their favourite book of the year! They have also completed their persuasive article about Bryher as a holiday destination, with many of the finished articles being typed up!

The children have also completed some comprehension questions relating to the final two chapters, they had to ensure that they had backed up their opinions with facts from the text. In mathematics they have continued to learn about volume and capacity, they have also moved onto investigating numbers up to ten million!

As part of their Anywhere Island topic, the children were challenged to create a holiday brochure for their island and one other form of advertising, this could have been a poster for a travel shop or a TV advert. The TV adverts that were produced were AMAZING! Well done everyone!
